Minutes of the City of Berryville April 11, 2023, City Council Meeting. Members present, Mayor Susan Morgan, Mayor Pro Tem Gayla Leary, Councilwoman Bobbie Evans, Councilman Terry Stubbins, and Councilman Walt Eastland. Councilman Lucas Wagenaar was absent.

1. Call the meeting to order and have a Moment of Silence.

Mayor Morgan called the meeting to order with a moment of silence.
